This Department Convention will be at the Best Western Plus Saddleback Inn & Conference Center, Oklahoma City from June 27-29. For reservations please call: toll free 800-228-3903 or direct 405-947-7000. When making your reservations be sure to mention you are with the DAV; our room rate is \$79.99 for King Bed or \$84.99 for Double Queens for single or double occupancy, which includes two breakfasts. The hotel will hold our block of rooms until the 6th of June. There is a weeklong Horse Derby in town so please make your reservation as soon as possible. Our Convention this year will be conducted entirely in the Saddleback Inn & Convention Center which is co-located with the Hotel.
